Project: Roadway Management - 2008

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Our Roadway Management Program performs various repairs, overlays, reconstructs, and improves drainage on town roadways. The selection of the roadways to be paved is based on a variety of factors including available funds, upcoming construction contracts, previous sewer contracts and the network priority rating as determined by the Town's pavement management system. In the summer of 2008 we contracted with Metro Northwest Consortium Roadway Management – North and P.J. Keating Company to perform the work.

Completion of Roadways started in 2007:

Connolly Road, Olney Street, Glade Street, Greenleaf Street, Forest Street, Farm Street, Branch Street, a portion of Andover Road, Allen Road Extension, and a portion of Ponderover Street. Work was completed in September 2008.

Paving on Sewer Contract 32A Roadways:

A portion of River Street, Westwood Avenue, Avila Road, Brentwood Place, Carmena Road, Avondale Avenue, Old Middlesex Turnpike, Esquire Road, Republic Road, and Applewood Avenue.

Drainage improvements were made to River Street, Brentwood Place and Republic Road as part of this phase.

The paving has been completed for these roadways.
